- The safety of you and your family is your responsibility, so make sure that children are looked after by a responsible adult at all times when watching the Torch Relay.
- Do not run out in front of or alongside the Torch Relay, where there will be moving vehicles. Use the safe places to watch where you see this symbol ††† on the map.
- Stand on the passenger door side of the road to watch the Torch Relay, except in pedestrian streets when you can watch from both sides.
- Free souvenirs of the Torch Relay will be given out by the sponsors only on the passenger door side of the Torch Relay.
- Watch the Torch Relay at the point closest to your home or place of work.
- Use public transport to travel to see the Torch Relay if you can.
- There will be no parking along the Torch route, so if you decide to drive, leave plenty of time and park in city centre car parks.
- Road closures in Worcester: the Torch Relay route shown on the maps overleaf will be closed from 18:00 hours to 20:00 hours on Thursday 24th May 2012 and from 07:30 hours to 09:00 hours on Friday 25th May 2012. Please watch out for signs along the route and if you need to travel, plan your journey well ahead as traffic may be delayed beyond these times in the city.
